1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Lincoln Street School offers three after-school arts education programs serving students in transitional kindergarten through eighth grade. The programs are Visual Arts for students in TK through grade 3, 3D Art for students in grades 4 through 8, and Music Production for students in grades 4 through 8. All three classes meet on the same afternoon each week, which allows siblings across grade levels to attend together and simplifies pickup for families. Approximately 30 students participate across the three offerings. Visual Arts introduces younger students foundational techniques in drawing, painting, and mixed media. The 3D Art class engages older students in sculpture and hands-on building projects. Music Production gives students an introduction to creating and recording their own music using digital tools. The programs are taught by certificated staff and represent Lincoln Street School's commitment to expanding arts access for all students.
