We are reaching out to communicate the timelines and requirements for parking permits for the 2025-2026 school year.

Parking Permit Requirements:

1. Complete the [Start Smart Program](#) (this class only needs to be completed once)
 - a. If you have not already completed the Start Smart class, here are the upcoming dates:
 - August 13, 2025 - 7pm @ DVHS [Registration Form](#)
 - September 17, 2025 - 7pm @ MVHS [Registration Form](#)
 - October 8, 2025 - 7pm @ SRVHS [Registration Form](#)
 - October 15, 2025 - 7pm @ CHS [Registration Form](#)
 - b. You must complete Step 1 before moving on to Step 2
2. Complete this [Google Form](#)

Once steps 1 and 2 are completed and all documents have been approved, the student and guardian will receive an email with instructions on how to pay for the parking permit. This email will also include parking spot information and details on where and when to pick-up the parking permit. Please also take a few minutes to review the [parking rules](#).

Parking Permit Timeline:

- ➔ Parking permits are going to be sold to **12th graders ONLY July 15 - August 15**
- ➔ Parking permit sales will be **CLOSED** from August 16 - August 19 to inventory remaining spots
- ➔ Parking permit sales will resume / reopen **August 20 to 12th & 11th graders**

We would also like to highlight that we greatly appreciate the support you provide our campus with your donations and purchases. The cost of the parking permits has not changed from last year. The back lot permit price is \$175 and the tennis court lot is \$225. We purchase the following via parking permit funding:

- Campus Monitor (for additional safety and support to keep our campus safe and secure)
- Overtime hours for our Custodians and Campus Monitors to keep our campus safe and clean
