October Count Each year, all public school districts across the state of Colorado participate in the Student October Count data submission to the Colorado Department of Education(CDE). The purpose of this data collection is to obtain required student level data as provided by the state statute. The October Count is the official student headcount for all Colorado public school districts that determines per pupil funding from the state. It is important to note that this data will impact the funding that RMSEL will receive. It is imperative that students attend school from September 24, 2025, through October 8, 2025. It is critical that we have all students in attendance on these days, especially on October 1, 2025, which is the official count date. 

#### **RMSEL Office Hours**



The RMSEL office is open daily from **7:30 am** and closes at **3:30 pm**. All visitors to the campus must ring the doorbell for access and present a driver's license for identification at the office.

If your child is absent from school, you may call the attendance line no later than 8:30 am, at **303-759-2076** and press **"1"** to notify the office, or email Jessica. Unverified absences will be marked as unexcused.

#### **Clothing Donation Bin at RMSEL**

85% of textile waste ends up in landfills, which equates to an astounding 22+ BILLION POUNDS of unnecessary dumping of clothes, shoes, and textiles into landfills each year. You can donate textiles (sheets, blankets, clothes, backpacks, jackets, stuffed animals, shoes, tablecloths, towels, purses, bags, etc.) Items should be bagged and dropped in our clothes bin located near the west end of the parking lot.

#### **Lost & Found Update**

Missing items? Check out the lost & found area located at the bottom of the stairwell to the left of the main door. The lost & found area is emptied prior to every school break or long weekend. #### Belay Fund

At RMSEL, we are aware that a variety of factors, combined with changes in the economic climate, can cause financial difficulties for families. Expenses that might contribute to hardship include the fieldwork and landmark trip fees at RMSEL. No child should ever be denied access to RMSEL's program because of financial constraints. We are fortunate to have families in our community who have both the means and the heart to provide support for students in this situation. This relationship is formalized through the RMSEL Belay Fund.

Medication Deadline In order to have adequate time for preparation of student medications and paperwork for crew trips, the following deadlines have been established for turning in medications for trips to the office. Please remember that all medication requires a completed and signed (by the physician) medication form. Medication must be in the original, labeled container, with the student's name, dosage instructions, and expiration date. Medications cannot be accepted after the stated deadline.

#### Volunteer and Bus Driver Certification

All RMSEL volunteers must go through a background screening that includes fingerprint processing through the CBI and FBI. Fingerprinting only has to be done once; it does not have to be renewed annually. You may access the Volunteer Packet at this <u>link</u> on our website. Bus driver certification is required before volunteers may drive RMSEL vehicles for trips. Bus Certification lasts for three years. Information for getting bus driver certification is included in the volunteer packet.
