a. PUBLIC HEARING: Consideration of approval of general waiver request in compliance with California Education code sections 33050-33053, and adopt resolution.

Pursuant to Education Code Sections 33050-33053 of the California Education Code, the District must conduct a public hearing on the General Waiver Request to provide the public to comment on the General Waiver Request. The CCR 3043 (d) stating that "an extended year program shall be provided for a minimum of 20 instructional days, including holidays." San Pasqual Valley Unified School District recommends providing extended school year (ESY) services for fewer than 20 days with the condition that 80 hours be provided. (A minimum of 76 hours of instruction may be provided if a holiday is included.) Also, special education and related services offered during the

extended year period must be comparable in standards, scope, and quality to the special education program offered during the regular academic year as required by California Code of Regulations, Title 5, (5 CCR), Section 3043(d).

SPVUSD proposes to provide ESY services utilizing a 14-day model over a three-week period at 6 hours per day (14 days X 6 hours per day = 84 hours), which provides more than the number of hours as in a traditional 20-day model, including holidays (20 days X 4 hours = 80 hours). The proposed model, which extends daily attendance time, results in more than the required time totals, but provides for a reduction in total days of attendance to 14 days, Monday through Friday, over a three-week period, excluding Juneteenth which is a holiday.
