



2026-2027 AP Exam Registration Info

AP Students and Parents/Guardians,

For most students, taking the AP Exams serves as the natural culmination of their AP course experience. Advanced Placement courses are designed to prepare students for a comprehensive College Board exam given in May 2027. If you have colleges in mind, check with their admissions office to learn about their AP exam credit policies.

Signing Up for AP Exams:

All students are required to register through College Board in [MyAP AND Total Registration](#) (2 Step Process).

- 1. Students will register with College Board in class with their AP teachers.**
- 2. Students will pay for their exams through Total Registration on their own, not in class.**

AP exam ordering takes place in the FALL semester. Cost for 2026-2027: \$110/ exam

Fee Reduction: Students may qualify for a fee reduction based on financial need as demonstrated by:

- Eligibility based on family size & annual family income

AP labels will be pre-filled through College Board with the information you provide and confirm. Please make sure your information is accurate in College Board and Total Registration.

Do NOT use your CUSD account to register. You must provide a personal email address.

This is a deadline driven process. Please be aware of and abide by the following key dates. We are unable to make exceptions for students who miss deadlines.

Sept. 1 - Oct. 30	AP Exam Registration Opens (via MyAP and Total Registration)
October 23	Final day to submit Fee Reduction Eligibility Form
October 30	Payment Window Closes - \$110/per exam*
October 30	Last day to request a full refund (see page 2)
Nov 2 – March 2	Late Registration (\$40 fee per exam)
Oct. 31 – March 2	Canceled Exam \$45 fee, partial refund \$65
March 3	No refunds if canceled after this day
May 3 - 7	1 st week of AP Exams
May 10 - 14	2 nd week of AP Exams

*All exams not paid in full by October 30, 2026 will be canceled and students will need to re-register if they would like to take the exam. **Students may register late from November 2, 2026 through March 2, 2026, however, there will be a **\$45 late fee per exam** during this period. Students must see Ashley Ickes in the Guidance Office to process the late registration.

Most exams are now only being offered digitally or Hybrid (digital and paper components) through

College Board. Students will need a CUSD Chromebook to take AP exams.

Accommodations: Students who have College Board approved accommodations will be able to use them for a digital exam just as they would a paper exam. **Please note, per the current policy for digital AP Exams, students must stay for the full duration of their approved extended time.**

Refunds: AP exams are given nationwide at the same date and time. AP exams are ordered directly from College Board and staffing is based on the amount of exams ordered. **Students may request a full refund from the AP Coordinator up until October 30, 2026 at 3:00pm. Partial refunds of \$65.00 per exam may be requested until March 2, 2027.**
