Need to change the 8th grade promotion rules	<p style="text-align: center;">2027 TRUSD Promotion Requirements</p> <p>To be eligible for promotion, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pass classes with grades of A, B, C, or D <p>To participate in the promotion ceremony, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Have no more than two academic “F”s in the 4th quarter/3rd trimester ● Have 90% attendance in the 4th quarter ● Have no more than 1 Q in attendance and 10 period lates excluding 1st period ● Have no home suspensions during the 4th quarter ● Clear all fines (textbooks, Chromebook, uniforms, equipment, etc.) ● Return the 8th grade promotion letter signed by both the student and parent/guardian

"Is there summer school this year for 8th grade?"	<p>Yes—summer school for 8th grade is held with the high school program and named “8-2-9.” Students participate in high school readiness activities, experiences with our CTE programs, and one course for high school credit toward graduation.</p>
