



RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NEVADA JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

MASTER PLAN RESOLUTION # 1-25/26

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees ("School Board") has determined that school facilities within the Nevada Joint Union High School District (the "District"), within the County of Nevada, need to be constructed, reconstructed, and modernized; and

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 17070.54 currently requires, as a condition of participating in the school facilities program, that a school district shall submit to the State Office of Public School Construction (OPSC) a five-year school facilities master plan, or updated five-year school facilities master plan, approved by the School Board of the Nevada Joint Union High School District,

WHEREAS, the School Board of the Nevada Joint Union High School District hereby acknowledges the following:

- (1) The master plan required by Education Code Section 17070.54 must be submitted to the OPSC by the time the application is processed by the OPSC.
- (2) The project(s) may be rescinded for failure to submit a master plan with the required components.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nevada Joint Union High School Board accepts and acknowledges that the above language applies to funding applications submitted under the School Facility Program for the following sites:

- Bear River High
- Nevada Union High
- North Point Academy

- Silver Springs Continuation High
- William & Marian Ghidotti High

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in addition to the projects listed above, the Nevada Joint Union High School Board accepts and acknowledges the above language applies to funding applications submitted under the State School Facility Program for any other projects as necessary in the District.
