Athletics:

- **Player of the Week:** Congratulations to our two Players of the Week: **Hudson Smith and Brooklyn Steele**. At the SFL Track & Field Meet #1 in the Long Jump, Hudson not only jumped a career high but also hit a national record of 24' 11". Hudson now owns the longest jump in the entire country! Additionally, during the games softball played, Brooklyn led the team with a .500 batting average, going 5-10 with 5 RBI's and hitting the game winning double in a tight 2-0 win against SFL powerhouse Del Oro. Congratulations to both Hudson and Brooklyn!
- **Third Quarter Grading Window:** attention Spring Athletes! The third quarter grading period ends March 20, 2026. Grades will be posted to Aeries by March 27, 2026.
 - All student-athletes must earn a minimum GPA of 2.0 for the grading period and
 - Student-athletes must have no more than 2 NM on their grade report.

Students will be granted two weeks from the end of the grading period to pass Essentials or make up Tests from this grading period to raise their grade and meet eligibility requirements.

 - Student-athletes will become ineligible for participation in athletic contests beginning on Friday, April 10, 2026 if they have 3+ NC or a GPA below 2.0.
