• Krista Ellis, BSN, RN: School Health Update

- o SHAC Report presented to school board in July by Jared Marcus
- Mental Health and First Aide Class was on July 28th, several more classes offered through the school year
- DSHS present at New Student Registration and at LMS Meet the Teacher to give vaccines-50 vaccines were given to 21 students on July 22nd and 36 vaccines were given to 18 students on August 4th
- o Each campus has a CERT/CERP team and district is eligible for Project Adam
- o CATCH Program still being utilized in the district
- o Good Side Health Telehealth still being utilized in the district

- o 3 students on catch-up schedules for vaccines
- 5 provisional enrollments
- 27 affidavits
- Hearing and Vision scheduled for October 15th
- o Increase in Covid and GI viruses
- Teachers have been encouraged to dis-infect, custodians are aware of classrooms with most incidence of illness
