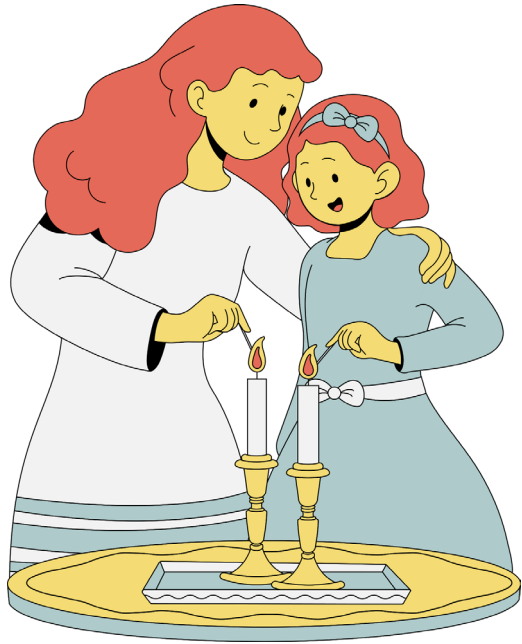
# special prayers


