STUDENT TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS

WHAT EMPLOYEES NEED TO KNOW



California Senate Bill 88 (SB 88) updates the requirements for anyone who is paid to transport students to or from school or school related activities.

Effective July 1, 2025, these requirements apply to school employees and contracted drivers who provide compensated student transportation.



WHAT IS SB 88?

SB 88 updated the requirements for anyone who is paid to transport students to or from school or school-related activities.



WHY WAS SB 88 CREATED?

SB 88 expands safety requirements so that all compensated student transportation providers meet consistent health, safety, and oversight standards, regardless of whether they work directly for a school district or through a private transportation provider.



OUR COMMITMENT

Student safety is our highest priority. By following SB 88 requirements, we help ensure every student is transported safely and responsibly.

WHO DOES IT APPLY TO?

SB 88 generally applies to employees or contracted drivers transporting students for:

- Home-to-school Transportation
- Field Trips
- Athletics
- Extracurricular Activities
- Preschool and Child Care Programs
- Other School Sponsored Activities

Certain exceptions may apply under state law.
