Student Absences

- Please call the day of the student absence before 8:30am. (508) 324-3160. Listen to the prompt and press #1 to leave a message. When your student returns, please send in a note to the teacher, even if you have called the absence in.
- Absences due to family vacations are considered UNEXCUSED. However, we understand that vacation time for working parents does not always coincide with that of the school district's.
- Work is NOT given out in advance of a vacation (see school handbook). Please let your child's teacher know the dates involved.
- *March, April and May are MCAS months, so please be mindful of the testing dates if you have a 3rd 4th or 5th grade student.

Student Dismissal

- If you are dismissing your child early, please send in a note to your child's teacher. Advance notice will assure that your child will be ready and on time with everything they need. If you need to dismiss unexpectedly, please call before 2:00 pm
- When you arrive at school to collect your child simply go into the office and your child will be called out of the classroom.
- Early dismissal may also mean you have a sick child that needs to go home. Either the custodial parents or those on the emergency slip will called.

Student Services and Information

- If there are medical issues or concerns about your child, please contact our nurse, Christine Bugara. 508-324-3160 ext. 104. Please do not send any medication to school WITH your child.
- Karina Sousa, our School Psychologist is on staff to work with students in individual and small group settings. Our school psychologist can also work with families to find services to assist a family in need. Ms. Sousa can be contacted via calling the main office.

Security at School

For the safety of all students and staff:

- All exterior doors are kept locked during the day. When visiting Chace, please enter ONLY through the main office and sign in with the secretary.
- ID is required to pick up a student.
- We have multi-security cameras installed throughout the building.
- Please do not approach students who are outside at recess or gym. Students are told not to approach anyone, even someone they know, when they are outside. Please come to the office if you need to see your child.
- Children will only be released to custodial parents and/or those on the emergency form. You must provide a note if your child is to be release to anyone else.

In Case of Snow or Emergencies...

The Somerset School Department only cancels school in the most severe weather conditions. In the event of a school delay, parents are expected to use their own judgment in sending children to school.

Announcements will be made through the ParentSquare app, as well as on local radio and television stations.

When a decision to delay school instead of cancel opening, a ninety (90) minute delay would result in school starting at 10:10 a.m., and a two hour delay would have school starting at 10:40.

Expectations for buses to pick-up students would be approximately 90 or 120 minutes later than the normal pickup time.
