PE WAIVER Read Carefully!

All students are required to complete four years of PE; however, students who are 16 years old or older and who have passed two years of PE during their freshman and sophomore years may opt-out of PE during their Junior and/or Senior years by requesting an exemption. A form must be completed each year.

Students without a waiver will be automatically scheduled into a PE Course.

UC Merced invites high school students to apply for computer science internship

Computer science and engineering Professor Ahmed Arif runs the program. Most of the applications he receives are from students in the Bay Area, and he said he would like to see more applicants from Central Valley, according to an article from UC Merced Public Information Officer Patty Guerra.

“Each year, I personally mentor four high school interns, teaching them how to conduct research responsibly, uphold strong ethical standards and gain hands-on experience in building real-world software systems,” Arif told Guerra. The internship is mostly virtual, lasts 12 weeks and requires 20 hours of work per week. Arif told Guerra that while demanding, the internship is flexible and can be worked around students’ schedules. “In research, you cannot schedule productivity,” Arif said. “Sometimes you’re in the mood to do it, and sometimes you’re not in the mood. 1ST FLOOR SERVICES

Academic Counseling

Meet with a counselor to get help completing an Education Plan (iSEP), declaring a major, or getting information on degrees and certificates. Academic counseling is available in-person, or virtually via video or phone. Schedule an appointment online or call the Center staff at **(916) 375-5511**.

DSPS Counseling and Accommodations

Career Services

Know Where to Park

Sacramento City College students, staff, and faculty need to **park in the designated LRCCD parking lot**. Please do not park in the lot directly in front of the West Sac Center to avoid getting a parking ticket. The time-restricted and designated parking spots are reserved for senior citizens, library customers, and electric vehicles.

Students can purchase a parking permit at the Front Desk or online via eServices.

Find your Classroom

The first digit of the room number indicates which floor the room is on. WSC stands for West Sac Center.

1st floor classes include **WSC 114, 115, 116**

2nd floor classes include **WSC 214, 215, 216, 217, 219, 220, 221**

3rd floor classes include **WSC 323**

Connect to Wifi

Students are able to connect to wifi by logging into the **LRCCD Network** with their **Los Rios W+ID + password**.
