STARs Program Internal Review and Continuous Improvement Summary

The Corning High School STARs Program completed its annual internal review process to evaluate program quality, student access, safety procedures, academic supports, enrichment opportunities, and alignment with the California Expanded Learning Quality Standards and Continuous Quality Improvement expectations.

The review process included:

- Analysis of student attendance and participation data
- Review of tutoring and credit recovery supports
- Evaluation of transportation access for rural students
- Review of student engagement opportunities and enrichment offerings
- Student and staff feedback
- Review of safety procedures, staffing structures, and program operations

Findings from the review indicated continued strengths in:

- Providing a safe and supportive after school environment
- Offering diverse student centered enrichment opportunities
- Reducing transportation barriers for rural students
- Supporting academic intervention through tutoring and credit recovery
- Building positive relationships between students and staff
- Providing access to nutritious after school meals

Areas identified for continued growth include:

- Increasing consistent student attendance
- Expanding student leadership opportunities
- Increasing student participation in STEM and career readiness activities

- Strengthening outreach to targeted student groups
- Continuing to expand opportunities for student voice and feedback

Program goals for the upcoming year include:

- Increasing student participation in enrichment and intervention opportunities
- Expanding career readiness and hands on learning experiences
- Strengthening supports for students experiencing chronic absenteeism or credit deficiency
- Continuing to reduce barriers for foster youth, homeless youth, English learners, and students with disabilities
- Maintaining a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment for all students

The STARs Program will continue to utilize data, stakeholder feedback, and ongoing Continuous Quality Improvement practices to guide future program development and ensure the program remains responsive to the needs of students and families.
