What is a “Join Code” and how do I receive one?

A join code is a specific code, given to you by your teacher, that allows you to access the classroom resources and is also the first part of the two-part registration process for ordering an AP exam. You will need a College Board account to join your AP class section and register for the AP exam in College Board. If you don't already have an account, please sign up here:

Does “joining” the class in College Board mean I MUST take the exam?

NO. Joining your class does not mean you MUST take the exam. You have to decide if you will or will not be taking the exam for each class. Exams are optional.

Why do I have to register in College Board and Total Registration?

Unfortunately, the College Board system does not take payment and this is why we need two systems. Joining your course through College Board populates your exam information and registering through Total Registration, completes the process by having you pay for the exam. Payment for exams will be handled entirely through Total Registration. NO payment will be taken on campus. If you have used Total Registration in the past, please use the same email address used previously to access your account.
