

WCHS Principal Board Report 9-3-2026



- The current enrollment is ten with one in long term independent study.
- We have had eight days of perfect attendance, six days with one absence, one day with two absences, and one day with three absences. As of August 28th, our August attendance average is 92.36%, compared to 84.74% at this time last year.
- Our Back to School event on August 12 was very well attended by students and parents. The taco dinner and student salsa competition were especially well received and helped create a welcoming and engaging atmosphere for families.
- The students appear to be enjoying the new schedule. Kaitlyn Swihart gathered feedback from students regarding the new schedule. Overall, the initial student response has been positive, with students describing the schedule as “more organized,” “on track,” and helping them feel that they are getting more done compared to last year. Students also noted that they are “more interactive with the lessons and each other.” Other students simply shared, “It’s not that bad,” “I like it. It’s good,” and “It’s organized.”
- The new Expository Reading and Writing Curriculum (ERWC) is going well. Students are beginning to understand the depth of thought and analysis required to respond to the questions and are becoming more comfortable with the expectations.
- All students are actively enrolled in the Butte College health class, and approximately half of the students currently have an A or B grade. This is a very encouraging start.
