



## What is the Tax Levy **Incentive Aid?**



- Allows school districts a one-time, additional adjustment above its 2% tax levy cap.
- Fills the gap for school districts below the adequacy threshold.
- Eligible districts: those whose prebudget year tax levy is less than the local fair share amount AND their adequacy spending is less than their adequacy threshold.
- Eligibility amount: \$347,931 (\$331,363 local tax levy; \$16,568 state aid)

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## Objectives for Additional Funding



- Address increasing need for Special Services
- Rising Out-of-District Tuition Costs
- Additional Staffing (Classroom Aides)
- Upgrade Math/Science Curricular Tools
- Safety/Security Hardware

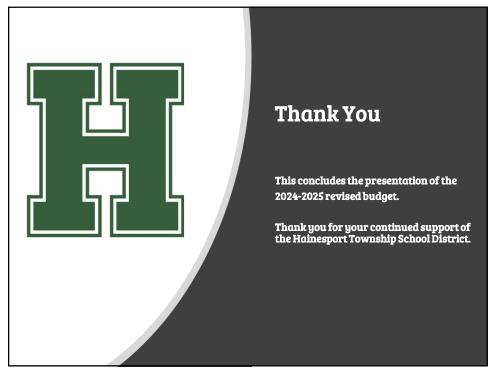
