### **1. Adoption of Revised 2025–26 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) to Include LREBG-Funded Action for Student Transportation Vehicle ACTION**

#### **Description:**

The revised 2025–26 LCAP includes an action funded by Learning Recovery Emergency Block Grant (LREBG) dollars for the purchase of a transportation vehicle. This addition supports the district's efforts to reduce chronic absenteeism by improving student access to school—an allowable use under Education Code Section 32526(c)(2) and based on needs identified in our local needs assessment.

The action aligns with the district's goals to:

- Improve attendance for unduplicated student groups, especially those in rural or underserved areas;
- Stabilize instructional access by removing transportation barriers; and
- Expand services in alignment with state priorities and Dashboard indicators.

The LCAP has been updated to reflect this action, including the related metric (chronic absenteeism), funding source, and rationale.

Recommended Action: Adopt the revised 2025–26 LCAP to include the LREBG-funded student transportation vehicle action.
