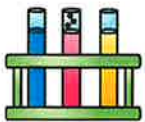

Keep practicing taking turns, playing with toys and cleaning up after.



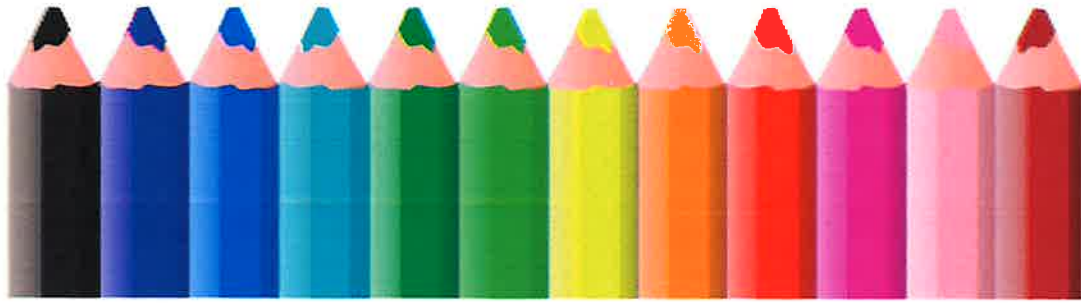

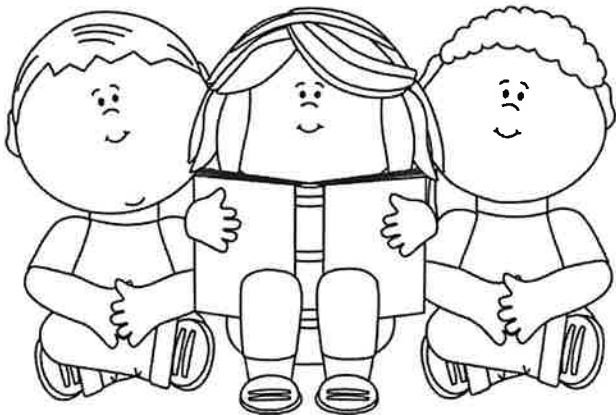
