Current criteria to qualify for TAG

- 1. SAGES (Screening Assessment for Gifted School Students) 30%
 - a. Administered in a group setting.
 - b. Assesses:
 - i. Verbal reasoning
 - ii. Non-verbal reasoning
 - iii. Mathematics/Science
 - iv. Language Arts/Social Studies.
- 2. Kaufman Brief Intelligence Test (KBIT) 60%
 - a. Administered in a one-on-one setting.
 - b. Assesses:
 - i. Verbal and nonverbal intelligence through word-image association
 - ii. Matrices
 - iii. Riddles
- 3. GATES (Gifted and Talented Evaluation Scales) 5%
 - a. Classroom teacher form that evaluates and rates a student's creativity and problem-solving abilities.
- 4. Classroom Grades 5%
 - a. Students must maintain a B or higher in their core subjects
 - i. Math, Science, Social Studies, ELA
