## Playoffs Begin


Playoffs have started for all Winter Sports. Make sure to attend their games and cheer them on!

Last day of Softball tryouts is tomorrow, Friday, from 3:45-4:00. See you there!





"Girls Basketball because they're tuff"




## Athletes of the Week
