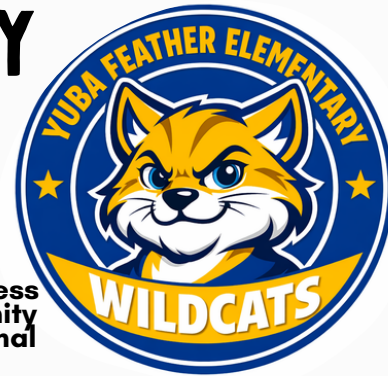

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

- Increased reading proficiency to 38% of all students at grade level or above in all grades
- Math proficiencies improving in grades 1-5 with 36% of students at or above grade level.

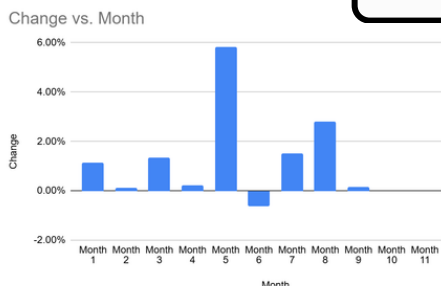
COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Community Food Distribution
 - Over 6200 pounds of food serving over 200 families
- Served over 350 meals at school sponsored family events
- Established MOU with Yuba Sutter Food Bank
- Established a community resource center to include clothing closet, shelf stable food and basic housewares for those in need.
