Monthly Update

Project Status



Planned Work

As we move into September, the landscape contractor is scheduled to begin planting with expectations to be completed by the end of the month. Following completion of the underground work along the Enloe frontage, the remaining portion of multimodal path will be competed. The electrical contractor has begun pulling wire to energize the traffic signal at Bruce and E. 20th St., and will begin pulling wiring for street and path lighting once traffic signals are completed. Final

Work on Bruce Road continues to progress towards completion, with most of the work completed. The past month has seen significant progress on both landscaping and the multi-modal path, and many of the sticking points to project completion having been resolved. Electrical service for street and path lighting as well as the traffic signal at Bruce Road and E. 20th St. has been established. Irrigation connections have all be completed and the underground work for Enloe Health's Gonzales Comprehensive Cancer Center is nearing completion.



roadway striping is pending remedial action on sections of the concrete roadway, for which the City and Contractor are currently engaged in negotiations.
