<u>Annual Update - Required for all families:</u>

The Annual Update is a required process for all students in SRVUSD and ensures that we have accurate information.

The Annual Update for your students needs to be completed by **Saturday**, **August 9th**. The Annual Update is a required task for ALL families, including returning students and new students enrolled on or before July 14, 2025.

Attendance:

Every Day Counts!!

It is essential that your child attends school daily and arrives on-time. Students miss instruction and shared class experiences that support learning and build community. Please align days off with the instructional calendar, try to arrange appointments for after school and keep your child home only when they are sick. When a student does have to miss school, please notify the school office by phone or by email. (925) 855-2898 or sy-attendance@srvusd.net. Please provide your child's first and last name (spell the last name), teacher's name / grade, and the reason for the absence.

Additionally, if your child has to be out of town during scheduled school days please know that, according to district policy, our teachers are not obligated to provide work while students are absent unless a parent/caregiver requests an **Independent Study Contract (ISC)**. Students are allowed no more than 15 school days for an Independent Study Contract per school year. Otherwise, make-up work will be waiting for the student in the classroom when the student returns to school. Here is the link to start the request if you would like.

School Site Council:


The School Site Council is a collaborative council composed of five parents, and five staff members (teachers, classified staff and school administration) and two alternate members. We meet five times during the year to review school data and progress towards goals, consider and provide feedback on the development of new goals for both the annual Site Plan for Student Achievement and the Comprehensive School Safety Plan. Drop Off / Pick Up:

In an effort to streamline drop off and pick up and alleviate the congestion on Camino Tassajara, please review the following graphic for details.

At drop off and pick up, please pull **all the way forward in the carline**. Once you are stopped in the carline, please have your child exit the car and then pull out. It causes undue congestion when cars stay in the carline in order to drop off at the top. Please be sure your child is ready to exit the car (ie. shoes on, breakfast eaten, etc.) and work with your child to exit the car independently on the curb side of the car. We ask parents not to get out of the car to assist children (this keeps the line moving along).

Do not drop off in the parking lot - this is unsafe for students and drivers who are exiting parking spots.



District Updates:

SRVUSD Mobile Communication Devices (MCDs) Policy:

Elementary School: Mobile Communication Devices (MCDs), including phones, smartwatches, and other wearable communication tools, must be turned off or silenced and stored during the school day for all students in preschool through grade 8. Devices should remain out of sight in backpacks or other designated storage and may not be used during class time, passing periods, recess, or lunch.

Middle School: Middle school students may only use their MCDs during the school day when a teacher gives permission for instructional purposes, and with approval from the principal or their designee.

High School: High school students may use their devices only during non-instructional time (e.g., breaks, lunch, passing periods). During classroom instructional time, MCDs must be turned off and put away, unless a teacher gives permission for academic use.

MCDs may not be used in a way that disrupts learning or violates others' privacy. If a student uses a device in an unauthorized way, it may be confiscated and disciplinary action may be taken, especially in cases of repeated misuse.

Exceptions may be made for health needs, emergencies, or when required by a student's IEP or 504 Plan, with appropriate documentation.

The district is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged devices brought to school.


Please use devices responsibly and follow all school rules to support a safe and focused learning environment.

Elementary (Preschool-grade 5)


Students may not use or have MCDs, including smart watches, visible at any time during the school day. Devices must be turned off or silenced and stored in backpacks or designated storage areas from arrival through dismissal. This includes time on campus before the morning bell, class time, recess, and lunch.



E-Bike Rules:

E-bikes and E-scooters have been observed being ridden on our athletic fields, particularly on the turf. **E-bikes and E-scooters are NOT permitted on any SRVUSD athletic fields.** Riding on the turf causes accelerated wear and tear, reducing its lifespan and increasing the need for costly repairs or replacement. Please remind students that bicycles and scooters should only be used on designated pathways.

Be A Mentor:

Volunteer Clearance - Reminder - NEW REQUIREMENTS

We ask all of our parents/guardians to register w/ Be A Mentor for level #1 - general volunteer. This clearance will allow you to be on campus and/or in the classroom with the children.

We are sharing important updates regarding the SRVUSD volunteer clearance process for the 2025-26 school year, specifically related to background checks, online training requirements, and associated fees. SRVUSD continues to partner with **Be A Mentor (BAM)** to manage volunteer clearance. This message is being shared with all current parents and caregivers, regardless of previous or current clearance status.

New Background Check and Training Requirements-

In alignment with <u>California State Assembly Bill 506</u>, effective July 1, 2025, all volunteers will be required to complete a Livescan fingerprint background check as well as mandated reporter and sexual harassment prevention training to be eligible to volunteer for the 2025-26 school year. Once fingerprinted for SRVUSD, volunteers will not need to repeat the process in future years.

Current Level 3 volunteers cleared through BAM: no action is required for the background check. Annual online training is required, and a current DMV driving report must be uploaded. Current Level 1 and 2 volunteers: You will receive an email from BAM prompting you to complete the new requirements.

Volunteers must complete all requirements before working at fall registration, classroom assignments, and all 2025-26 school events. Volunteers in the BAM system who have not completed all requirements will be unable to volunteer until clearance is complete.

<u>New Volunteers</u>: Level 1 volunteer or Level 2 volunteer, with driving: Please submit your <u>volunteer application</u> through BAM to begin the clearance process.

Effective July 1, 2025, volunteers will be classified as Level 1 (cleared for all events, no driving) or Level 2 (cleared for all events, including driving). Current Level 3 volunteers will be reclassified to Level 2.

Livescan Fingerprint Fees-

Due to Board-approved budget reductions, SRVUSD is making adjustments in several areas, including the fees associated with background checks for volunteers and staff. These changes are essential to responsibly address the district's financial situation while upholding our commitment to providing a high-quality education for all students.

Effective immediately, all applicants and volunteers—regardless of clearance level—will be responsible for covering the full cost of their Livescan fingerprinting through a service provider of their choice.

SRVUSD will no longer cover Livescan fingerprinting expenses. In addition to the fingerprinting fee, which is paid directly to the Livescan provider at the time of service, BAM will collect a \$25 processing fee from each applicant or volunteer. Since rolling fees vary by provider, we recommend contacting your preferred Livescan location for specific pricing. BAM will provide a list of approved providers.

Note: A TB test is also a requirement. The TB test is good for 4 years. The risk assessment form is to be completed by your doctor. You will need to upload, to your Be A Mentor account, either the completed risk assessment form or the negative TB test result form from your doctor.

NEW SRVUSD VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

In alignment with <u>CA State Assembly Bill 506</u>, effective July 1, 2025, all volunteers will be required to complete a Livescan fingerprint background check as well as mandated reporter and sexual harassment prevention training to be eligible to volunteer for the 2025-26 school year.





Water Bottles and Lunch Boxes are on the shelf in the MPR.


