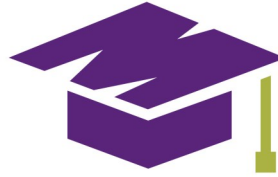

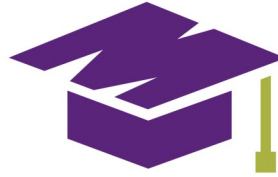

### **4.0 Treasurer's Reports**

#### **4.1 Financial & Treasurer's Reports**

Shelley Deniz reported the beginning balance as of July 1, 2024, was \$23,211.16. Income from dues was \$4,320.00. Income from guest dinners/no shows was \$340.00. The total income equaled \$4,660.00. Total expenses equaled \$2,327.98. Leaving an ending balance of \$25,543.18 as of February 12, 2025. The Treasurer's Report shows the detail of these figures. All dues have been paid.

#### **4.2 Scholarship Summary**

The beginning balance was \$516. Donations received during the 2022-2023 school year were \$1,168.00. Scholarships awarded in June 2024 equaled \$1,684.00. Five scholarships at \$200 each were claimed for a total of \$1,000.00. Donations received during 2023-2024 equaled \$1,361.00 making the scholarship funds available for June 2025, \$2,045.00

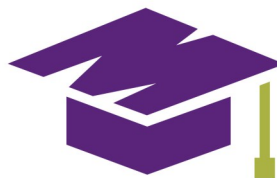
