According to Education Code Section 47602(b), “No charter school shall receive any public funds for a pupil if the pupil also attends a private school that charges the pupil’s family for tuition.” I hereby declare that my child **will not** be enrolled as a student in a private school or other public school while he/she is enrolled in ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL.

10. ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL adheres to all provisions of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Parents who choose to place their children in ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL are aware that:
- a. Each student identified with special needs must have an IEP stating that Independent Study is an appropriate placement for that student.
  - b. A representative from your previous district may be invited to participate as a member of the IEP team.
  - c. Attendance for special education services is monitored to ensure access to all services outlined on a student's IEPs. If a special education student misses services, the AGCS Special Education Department will contact the family. If additional special education meetings with a provider are missed, an IEP meeting will be called to ensure the charter school's homeschool / personalized learning model remains an appropriate placement for the student, and to discuss steps the IEP team will take to carefully monitor progress toward goals that assures educational benefit for the student.
  - d. If the IEP team determines that ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL is not an appropriate placement for the student, then the IEP team will offer an appropriate placement.

11. BY SIGNING BELOW, STUDENT/PARENT UNDERSTANDS THE FOLLOWING:

- a. This student is entitled to school services including, but not limited to, school personnel, a credentialed teacher, textbooks, and supplementary materials.
- b. Each student has a standard maximum amount of allocated funds for that student's educational program.
- c. No more than **twenty** (20) school days may pass between when an assignment is made and the date by which the student must complete the assigned work. The number of missed assignments that will be allowed before an evaluation is conducted to determine whether it is in the best interest of the student to remain in independent study shall be **two** (2).
- d. Enrollment in the charter school program is an optional educational alternative that is voluntarily selected.
- e. No pupil shall be involuntarily removed by the charter school for any reason unless the parent or guardian of the pupil has been provided written notice of intent to remove the pupil no less than five school days before the effective date of the action.
- f. By signing this contract, I, the undersigned, understand the Charter school's philosophy, program, and requirements. As a parent, I accept FULL responsibility for my child's education. ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL is a charter school that is structured to allow a new and different approach to the education of my child. This innovative approach may not be appropriate for all children. Should my child require personnel and services in addition to those provided by the ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL Personalized Learning Program, I understand that the staff of ALDER GROVE CHARTER SCHOOL will assist me in re-enrolling my child in our district of residence.
