The CBOC is responsible for ensuring that Measure J bond funds are used in accordance with the ballot measure approved by voters and applicable laws. This application will help determine your eligibility and suitability for serving on the committee.

Additional Information:

- **Residency:** Residency within the District is not required; however, the Board strongly prefers that members of the COC live or work within the boundaries of the District.
- **Minimum Membership:** The committee must have at least **seven members** representing specific stakeholder groups.
- **Member Terms:** Members serve for a two-year term and can serve no more than three consecutive two-year terms (maximum of six years total).
- **Vacancies:** If a member resigns or is unable to fulfill their term, the district may appoint a replacement to serve the remainder of the term.
- **Removal:** Members can be removed for cause, such as failing to attend meetings or violating conflict of interest policies.
- **Volunteer Position:** Serving on the SBOC is a voluntary, unpaid position.
