Review of LCAP presentation

- Metrics

- Part of the process is to make sure that we are collaborating with stakeholders
- Currently going to DELAC, BDAC, Principals, other staff members, survey sent out
 - Reviewing data with internal Ed Services team, Business Department and talk about how things are going
 - Presented in easy to understand language
- LCAP - 3 year plan (currently in year 2 of the plan)

LCAP Goal 1: ensure a safe and productive learning environment that promotes wellness and a positive culture for all students

- Review of suspension and chronic absenteeism data
 - Suspension declined by 0.7%
 - Chronic absenteeism declined by 1.5%
- Review of Metrics
 - Attendance rates: 98.04%
 - Chronic absenteeism Rates: 6.96%
 - Hispanic 15.68%
 - African American- 14.77%
 - Suspension Rate- 0.19%
 - Hispanic - 0.5%
 - Socio-economically disadvantaged - 0.3%
 - English Learners - 0.25%
 - African American - 0%
 - Expulsion Rate - 0%

ELA- Maintained in Green: 0.2 pts

Math- maintained green: 0.4 pts
EL Progress Declined 6.7% in the orange
Science- Maintained in green at 0.7 points (do not count this year)

Review of Goal #2 - Actions and budget

Fully Implemented

Basic instructional services, instructional coaches, SEAL contract, ELD curriculum (MS), AVID contract, Math training with SVMl, SVEF after-school and summer classes, Summer School program, Mandarin Immersion program, art teachers, PE aide, technology support, transitional kindergarten, Illuminate (now called Renaissance)

Partially Implemented

- Mindful Leaders (Dr. Niki) training
- AVID tutors and extra duty
- SVMl training
- Math training with SVMl

Not being fully Implemented

- Walkthroughs with New Teacher Center
- Imagine Learning (now using Freckle)

Review of items included

- CA Healthy Kids Data survey
 - 5th through 8th grade
 - 5th and 6th opt-in
 - 7th and 8th opt out
 - Provides more comprehensive school climate and culture data
 - Fall data is baseline data moving forward since it is new this school year

Review of Actions and Budget

- Fully implemented
 - Translators, additional translator support with Communicaid, Parent Square, Parent Engagement workshops that include childcare and materials

Review of Survey Ratings for Each Action Item

- Parent Square question: Why is other parent information not shared?
 - Answer: Confidentiality of our families' information
 - Goal was to have just one platform with Parent Square, but some teachers still using other platforms
 - Goal of adding more awareness around Parent Square platform
 - Questions around: childcare and parent workshops
 - How is childcare offered? What parent workshops has the district done?

Reviewed LCAP Stakeholder Feedback Timeline

- BDAC, DELAC, Principal Meetings and LCAP Committee Meetings
- Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent going out to visit with students at each school site
- Will be taken to the school board for approval in June 2026
