DMUSD announces Instructional Services leadership selections

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Following a rigorous and thoughtful selection process, the Del Mar Union School District Board of Trustees approved three key Instructional Services leadership selections during its June 24 board meeting, according to a news release . Abby Domingo was named Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services; Aaron Nelson was named Director of Curriculum and Instruction; and Angie Tremble was named Coordinator of Assessment, Data, and Integrated Technology, according to a news release.

Each individual earned their position for their professional expertise, leadership capacity, commitment to students, and alignment with the district's vision for meaningful, future-ready learning, the news release stated.

Domingo has served the Del Mar Union School District for more than 20 years in a variety of instructional and leadership roles, including classroom teacher, assistant principal, principal, and, most recently, Director of Curriculum and Instruction. Throughout her service in DMUSD, Domingo has demonstrated a deep commitment to meaningful, equitable, and high-quality learning experiences for students, while leading important districtwide work aligned to the district's Strategic Plan and instructional frameworks. Her leadership has supported professional learning, assessment and reporting practices, STEAM+ programming, Spanish Language Immersion, and collaboration across departments and school sites, the news release stated.

"Abby is known for her collaborative leadership, thoughtful communication, and commitment to gathering input and building shared understanding," said Marisa Janicek, superintendent of the Del Mar Union School District, in the news release. "Her strong relationships across the district, deep knowledge of DMUSD's instructional frameworks, and student-centered approach will serve her well as she continues advancing the exceptional work already underway in our district."

The board also approved Aaron Nelson as DMUSD's new Director of Curriculum and Instruction, the role previously held by Domingo. Nelson is an accomplished educational leader with more than 20 years of experience across elementary, middle, and high school settings. He most recently served as principal in Carlsbad Unified School District. Nelson brings strong experience in curriculum implementation, instructional improvement, professional learning, Project-Based Learning, STEAM programming, and learner-centered school design, the news release stated.

Selected as Coordinator of Assessment, Data, and Integrated Technology, Tremble will provide important support during an upcoming department retirement. Tremble joins DMUSD following 22 years with the Solana Beach School District, where she served as principal of Solana Ranch Elementary School. In this role, she will support assessment, data-informed instruction, instructional technology, and high-quality instructional practices across the district.

"We are thrilled to welcome Aaron and Angie to DMUSD," Janicek said in the news release. "Aaron's instructional leadership and experience across grade levels, along with Angie's expertise in assessment, data, and technology, will strengthen the support we provide to students, educators, and school communities across the district." Domingo, Nelson, and Tremble begin in their new roles this month.

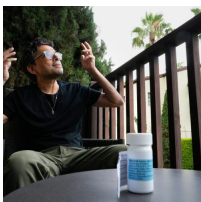
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
