October Count

Each year, all public school districts across the state of Colorado participate in the Student October Count data submission to the Colorado Department of Education (CDE). The purpose of this data collection is to obtain required student level data as provided by the state statute. The October Count is the official student headcount for all Colorado public school districts that determines per pupil funding from the state. It is important to note that this data will impact the funding that RMSEL will receive. It is imperative that students attend school from September 24, 2025 - October 8, 2025. It is critical that we have all students in attendance on these days and in particular on October 1, 2025, which is the official count date.
