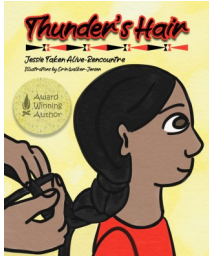

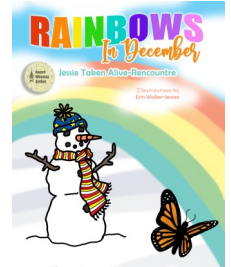

She was named the Great Plains Emerging Tribal Writer's Award winner for her 1st children's book *Pet'a Shows Misun the Light*. Utilizing her teachings from her Lakota culture combined with a school counselor lens, she has published 7 children's books, with more in the works. Her passion is to help people remember their importance in life and to utilize their unique talents, to create better communities for future generations to come. She is also a Lakota Jingle Dress Dancer and loves to educate others about Lakota culture using storytelling combined with traditional song and dance. In 2021, Jessie was named a future legacy leader by the Spirit Aligned Leadership Program, an international organization.
