

Aptos High School 2025–26 SPSA Overview

Aligned with PVUSD's LCAP Goals & WASC Recommendations

Goal 1

■ **Target:** Increase students passing A–G courses with a C- or better by 2% annually.

■ **Strategies:**

- Equitable grading practices & D/F monitoring
- Tutorials & quarterly grade analysis
- AVID strategies; expand to CTE pathways
- 4-year plans, counselor training (ASCA/CCGI)
- Expand UCSC ACCESS, AP/Honors enrollment
- Career readiness: speakers, internships

■ **Outcomes:**

- CSU eligibility ↑ 5% (58%→63%)
- UC eligibility ↑ 4% (51%→55%)
- 10th-grade D/Fs need improvement

■ **Budget:** \$30,000

Goal 2

■ **Target:** Increase students earning C- or better by 5% (focus: EL, migrant, SED, IEP/504).

■ **Strategies:**

- Learning Walks & teacher collaboration
- PD: book study, data monitoring
- MAP data for math placement; Tier 2 supports
- Student/family engagement in grading
- Supports for IEP/504 & English Learners
- Math & Science interventions

■ **Outcomes:**

- 3 of 5 subgroups ↑ ≥5%
- English Learners: +16.7% proficiency
- Migrant students: no growth
- Hispanic SBAC scores ↓ in Math & ELA

■ **Budget:** \$24,000

Goal 3

■ **Target:** Increase participation in activities/positive behaviors by 5% (via 5-Star points).

■ **Strategies:**

- PBIS/MTSS Committees monitor data
- Tier I staff trainings; SEL/mental health PD
- Recognitions: Mariner Moments, Dept Awards
- Clubs, arts, athletics promotion
- Student Wellness Program expansion
- PBIS incentives/events

■ **Outcomes:**

- MTSS 'Highly Effective' + Gold CA PBIS recognition
- Chronic absenteeism ↓ 33%→22%

- 5-Star Tuesday & Fest expanded

■ **Budget:** \$26,620

Goal 4

■ **Target:** Increase parent participation in events, ACCESS, & programming.

■ **Strategies:**

- Parent info & outreach on college/career
- Events w/ translation & refreshments
- Welcoming culture with awards & support
- ParentSquare training & communication

■ **Outcomes:**

- 4 parent advisory sessions (attendance: 1–15)
- Low participation from Spanish-speaking families

■ **Budget:** \$5,000
