Back to School Tips for Fall

Summer is a great time to master skills that help students be successful here at school. Here are a few things parents can practice at home to make the transition back to school smoother come Fall:

- Practice playing on playground equipment and following safety rules (e.g. down the slide, one direction on the monkey bars).
- Practice with students the lunchtime routine, including opening different snacks and focused eating (students have a short window for lunchtime).
- Sit and read with your student to practice listening and managing their body while sustaining attention.
- Participate in events and activities that give students an opportunity to play with peers and meet new people.
- Discuss the routine of school and walk the campus to help kids get familiar with the different areas of school and drop off/pick up.
