RMSEL uses the Expeditionary Learning Instructional Framework. This framework is progressive, in that the curriculum focuses on the gradual mastery of Colorado Academic Standards, as well as a final graduation portfolio. Concurrently, our graduation requirements build toward a mastery of understanding and a rigorous completion of content as credit is obtained.

New students may be admitted to RMSEL through grade 11 with equivalent credit from their previous high school.

In addition to these academic requirements, students are expected to attend and submit portfolio documents for our expeditionary Learning Outward Bound Crew Trips as part of their credit requirements.
