Cybersecurity, Minecraft & 2D Game Programming

Hack. Build. Create.

This course lets students turn their interest in games into real skills. Students learn how coding and cybersecurity work together, including how hacking happens and how systems stay secure. They then use those skills to design and build games using Minecraft and 2D game development tools.

This class is hands-on and project-based. Students write code, create interactive games, and develop problem-solving skills used in technology and game-related careers.
