



2026 SUMMER SCHOOL

Summer School is available for students who attend a school in the Shasta Union High School District. Ninth-grade core classes (English, Math, Social Science, and Science) will be offered in a Direct Instruction format. All other grade-level courses will be in an online format (in person) using the Imagine Edgenuity platform.

DATES, LOCATION, AND TRANSPORTATION:

- Summer School will be from June 10th – July 8th
- Summer School is from 8:00 am - 2:45 pm
- Summer School location will be at Enterprise High School
- Transportation will be provided from Foothill and Shasta to Enterprise High School (FHS p/u@7:25 am by flagpole; SHS p/u@7:25 am by flagpole; Return busses depart@2:50 pm arriving 3:10 pm)

FORMAT OF INSTRUCTION:

- Students are required to attend daily until Summer School has ended.

DAILY CLASS SCHEDULE:

- 1st period: 8:00 am - 10:00 am
- 2nd period: 10:15 am - 12:15 pm
- 3rd period: 12:45 pm - 2:45 pm

ATTENDANCE:

All students will be **REQUIRED** to attend each day that school is in session.

- There are NO EXCUSED absences.**
- Upon the 3rd day of absences, the student may be dropped from the course and receive no credit.**
- Tardy Policy: 3 tardies to any one class will equal 1 absence; 3 total absences may result in dismissal from that course.**
