1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

During the 2024-25 school year, East Side Union High School District utilized Proposition 28 funding to expand access to arts education across all high schools. Each site developed a plan that reflected student interest, staff capacity, and program needs, consistent with the district's goal of providing equitable, well-rounded learning opportunities. Sites directed their 20% allocation toward materials, equipment, and added contract services that immediately supported student engagement in the arts. Purchases included instruments, sheet music, theater equipment, visual arts supplies, and digital media resources. These investments have had an immediate impact, allowing students to participate in courses and extracurricular activities with the tools and resources necessary for meaningful learning. At this time, the district has not yet expended the 80% allocation designated for staffing. This is primarily due to the hiring and contracting timelines required to identify credentialed arts educators and align new positions with collective bargaining agreements. Our district is committed to using these funds in full compliance with Proposition 28's requirement that at least 80% support staffing, and we are in the process of finalizing job descriptions, working with labor partners, and initiating recruitment to ensure qualified staff are in place. Once hired, these positions will expand opportunities in music, theater, and visual arts and support new programming aligned with site-level needs. Looking ahead, our priority is to fully implement the staffing portion of the allocation to sustain and grow arts programs across all sites. By combining immediate investments in materials with upcoming staffing additions, we are building a strong foundation for equitable access to high-quality arts education for all East Side Union students.
