RESOLUTION NO. 18, 2025-2026**

ESTABLISHMENT OF HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH

WHEREAS, it is necessary to instill in our youth the importance of education, history, and self-determination in creating eminent role models; in establishing a proud cultural identity; and in producing exceptional citizens of this nation; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic Heritage Week, which began in 1968 under President Lyndon B. Johnson, was expanded to National Hispanic Heritage Month by President Ronald Reagan and enacted into law in 1988 to cover a 30-day period starting on September 15, the day which represents the anniversary of independence for five Latin American countries; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic students comprise approximately 28% of the Elk Grove Unified School District student population; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic Americans are a diverse group that represents numerous ethnicities and geographic and political regions identifying with a variety of terms including Latinx, Latino/a, Hispanic, Chicanx, Chicano/a, and country-specific terms; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic Americans may also trace their roots to the Indigenous peoples of the Americas; and

WHEREAS, the accomplishments of this group span the fields of medicine, law, education, agriculture, sports, the arts, science, business, and government; and

WHEREAS, the cultural influences of this group have been remarkable in the food, language, and music of American culture; and

WHEREAS, awareness of these contributions should be a part of a full understanding of our shared history and culture;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of Elk Grove Unified School District that September 15 through October 15, 2025, is designated as Hispanic Heritage Month and that all educational sites are encouraged to recognize the contributions of Hispanic Americans through our curriculum and activities at the school.
