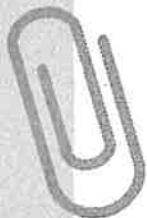

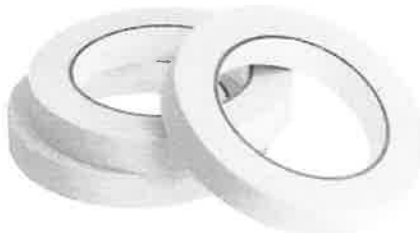

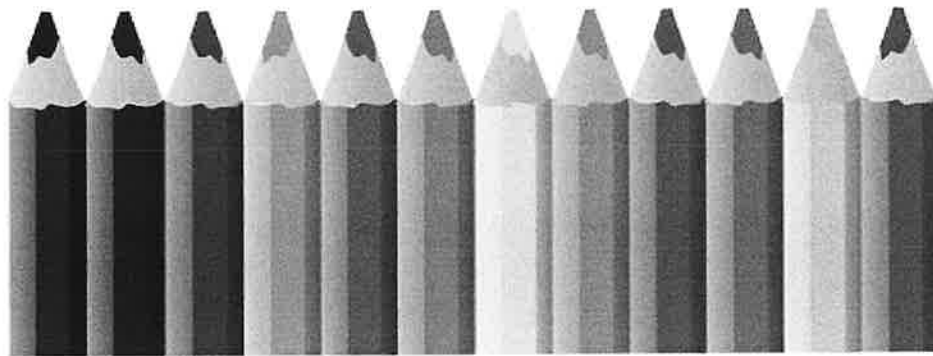
# **1st grade Supply List**

**Dear Future Fourth Grade Parents,**

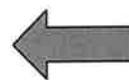

**Students NEED:**

- a set of headphones or earbuds (to keep at school)

- (6) yellow #2 sharpened pencils
- pair of scissors
- A set of (12 COUNT or more) colored pencils (Twistables are GREAT)

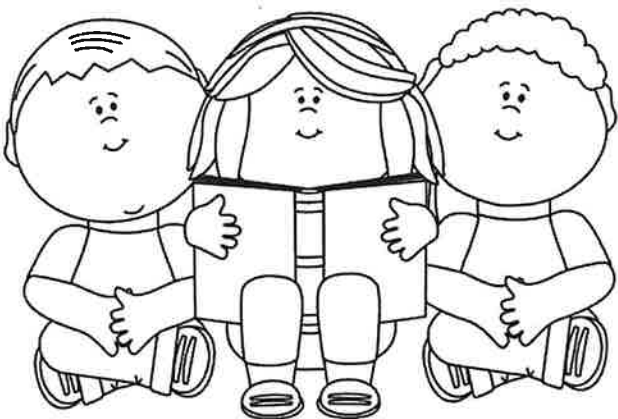
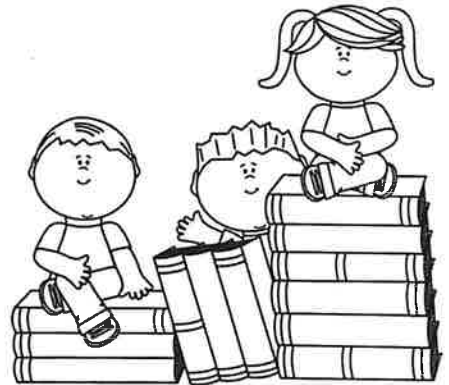
