En El ELPAC sumativo del 2023-24, 15% de los alumnos aprobaron el examen con un nivel 4.

Muchos de los alumnos se estancan en el nivel 3.

Data Presentation

In the 2023-24 summative ELPAC, 15% of students passed the exam with a level 4.

Many students are stuck at level 3.

The ELA Benchmarks exam is the district's exam, and high school students take it four times a year. Elementary school children only take the exam three times a year, every quarter.

Si los estudiantes de la high school no tienen suficientes créditos, no se gradúan. Para los niños de la high school, los grados/calificaciones que quedan en su currículum, son las de media año, y las de fin de año.

If high school students don't have enough credits, they don't graduate. For high school students, the grades left on their resume are the midterm and final grades.

Math Benchmarks:

For high school students, there are four tests.

In elementary school, there are the SWUM tests. Children take three tests.

Number of English Learners in 2023-24.

Each classroom can have up to 32 children in grades 4 and up. In elementary school, grade 4 has the most English learners. In high school, grade 10 has the most English learners.

A quarter of children are English learners at the district level.

The state and county rates are 18.4%.

Long-Term English Learners

These are students who, after being English learners for more than six years, have not been reclassified.

In 10th grade, several children are stuck at Level 3 on the ELPAC.
