ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH

WHEREAS, people of Native American heritage have played a significant role in the history of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the United States has paused to recognize the contributions of these citizens throughout the course of our history; and

WHEREAS, President George H. W. Bush in 1990 proclaimed November to be National American Indian Heritage Month; and

WHEREAS, we acknowledge these Americans for their contributions to government, industry, commerce, agriculture, science, literature, and the arts; and

WHEREAS, Section 51204.5 of the California Education Code states that instruction in social sciences shall include the early history of California and a study of the role and contributions of men and women, Native Americans, African Americans, Mexican Americans, Asian Americans, Pacific Islanders, European Americans, lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender Americans, persons with disabilities, and members of other ethnic and cultural groups, to the economic, political, and social development of California and the United States of America with particular emphasis on portraying the role of these groups in contemporary society; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Elk Grove Unified School District that November 2025 is designated as Native American Heritage Month and that all educational sites be encouraged to recognize the contributions of Native Americans through our curriculum and activities at the school.
