Timeline Noncompliance Prong I

The CDE Data Evaluation and Analysis team has provided the SELPA with an updated student list of students who were identified as noncompliant in their Annual Determination Letter (ADL) AND continue to be enrolled and noncompliant as of February 27, 2026. Identify students requiring DRDP for Spring 2026

A DRDP is required for students ages 0-5 years, including TK and Kindergarten, unless they turn 6 within the school year. If the student enrolled in the district after 4/1/2026, it is not required to complete a DRDP. The requirement falls on the district where the student was enrolled on 4/1/2026.

- Assessments began March 2nd Deadline for reporting
- Spring DRDP is due May 15th.

New Training Requirements

Current DR Access Learn required training courses will no longer be available after March 2, 2026, as they are being updated to support DRDP 2025. See important updates and requirements [here](#).

Monitor SEIS Dashboard - Help your DLU prepare for EOY!

- Monitor your CALPADS alerts, including students who require Post-secondary Transition Plans, Program Setting changes, and Plan Type changes.
- Follow up on meetings that are unaffirmed or unsigned to ensure completion.
- Review overdue meetings listed in your Meeting Alerts and take action to resolve outstanding items or delay codes.
- Audit your caseloads to ensure that all students are correctly assigned.

CALPADS Multifactor Authentication transition window, March 10th through May 1st

CALPADS is upgrading to a new system that supports multifactor authentication (MFA) to enhance data security for the 2025–26 school year. This security measure requires users to provide two or more forms of verification, such as a password and a code from a mobile app before accessing the system. [CALPADS Update Flash #319](#)
