<p>Submission Format Clarification: The RFQ/P guidelines state that BCOE will only accept electronically submitted packets, but also request five bound copies, one unbound copy, and one electronic copy. We are clarifying whether hard copies are required, where they should be delivered if so, and if the electronic copy can be submitted via email and not on a flash drive.</p>	<p>-Submission Format Clarification: Hard copies are required and can be sent to 1859 Bird Street, Oroville, CA 95965, attention Thomas Flanagan. The electronic copy can be submitted to the email address outlined in the Submission Deadline details. We only require one electronic copy.</p>
<p>Safety Criteria – EMR Letter: The selection criteria for the project includes safety as an evaluation factor. We want to know if an Experience Modification Rate (EMR) letter would satisfy this requirement and where in the RFQ/P we should include this documentation.</p>	<p>-Safety Criteria – EMR Letter: The BCOE will accept an EMR Letter; please list it as an exhibit in the table of contents and incorporate it accordingly.</p>
<p>Submission Deadline: The current deadline for the RFQ/P submission is September 1. Since this date falls on Labor Day, a federal holiday, we are clarifying whether the deadline will be extended to the next business day, September 2.</p>	<p>-Submission Deadline: The BCOE has issued an addendum extending the deadline to September 2, 2025</p>
<p>Critical Path Schedule: The RFQ/P states material must be in 8½ x 11-inch format. Can the Critical Path Schedule be presented in 11 x 17-inch format for readability purposes?</p>	<p>-Critical Path Schedule: Yes, the BCOE will accept this document in an 11 X 17 format.</p>
