Dear RMSEL Community,

I hope you all enjoyed your Labor Day weekend and were able to relax and do the things that fill your cup and your soul. I want to take a moment to reinforce safety expectations that must be upheld in order to maintain the safety of our students and community members:

- 1. All visitors, including parents, must check in at the main office, run their ID through the Raptor system, and receive a visitor's badge if you plan to be in the building beyond the main office. If you are volunteering on a crew trip or field work, we still require you to have a visitor's badge if you are in the building. This helps us to identify quickly who has and has not been cleared through our Raptor system and who may or may not be safe to be in the building.
- 2. Please drive safely through the parking lot at all times. This means drive 10 mph or less, be aware of all pedestrians, and drive to the right of cones if you are dropping off/picking up and to the left of the cones if you are driving through.

Thank you so much for your patience with our new communication platform, ParentSquare. The reason for shifting to this platform is to allow us to easily send text messages, emails, urgent alerts, and posts to the whole school, specific groups of parents, whole grade levels, and from teacher/staff to individual families. Whether it's event reminders, forms, schedule changes, or classroom news, ParentSquare keeps all of our school communication in one place.

As communicated yesterday, unfortunately, the first round of verification emails was also sent to all emergency contacts listed in Infinite Campus, not just guardians. To correct this, I have removed those contacts and will resend verification emails only to guardian email addresses. This means you will receive another verification email later this week or early next week. I apologize for the confusion and appreciate your patience as we get ParentSquare set up correctly. Once launched, we're confident it will be a valuable communication tool for our community.
