The purpose of this memo is to inform the project sponsor (City of Chico) that the Interagency Consultation Review (ICR) Group has completed its review of the Project Level PM2.5 Conformity Assessment of the City of Chico's Eaton Road and SR 99 Southbound Ramps (Roundabout) (CTIPS ID# 102-000-0249) and concurs with the project sponsors recommendation that the project is not a "Project of Air Quality Concern".

The Eaton Road and SR 99 Southbound Ramps (Roundabout) Project is being processed pursuant to Section 326. Accordingly, Michael Dorantes of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Rodney Tavitas of Caltrans have provided concurrence with the project sponsor's determination that the Project does not constitute a "Project of Air Quality Concern" for the purposes of their respective agencies.
