

CHARTER EXTENDED DAY SUMMER PROGRAM 2026

Important Information

To ensure a positive experience for your child at the Charter Extended Day summer program, please note the following:

- Children must be signed "in" and "out" by a parent or guardian, daily.
- There will be many new and unfamiliar staff members working at our summer sites. To assist us in assuring your child's safety, please be prepared to present identification upon request.
- **Please provide an ample lunch for your child.** A small morning and afternoon snack and/or drink is provided daily. Feel free to send an additional snack with your child if you think they will require one. (All lunches and snacks must be sent in a bag or lunch box clearly marked with your child's name.) Please do not send food that needs refrigeration, heating, or any kind of preparation.
- It is recommended for your child to bring a water bottle (no glass) clearly marked with their name.
- If your child needs medications while at Extended Day, it is your responsibility to complete a Medications Assistance Waiver (if not already in place) and transport the medications to the Summer Center.
- The children will spend a great deal of time outside in the sun during the day. We strongly recommend you **send sunscreen** for your child. For more information see our [Sunscreen Policy](#).
- On swim days, all children will be transported by bus to the pool. For your child to swim, you must provide a swimsuit and towel in a backpack or duffle bag that is clearly marked with their name. More information regarding swim will be provided prior to the start of the summer program.
- Personal items such as games, toys (including those resembling weapons), trading cards, money, etc., are not allowed in Extended Day. Extended Day is not responsible for any damage to, or theft of, these items and will not investigate or participate in attempts to recover any lost or stolen items. All electronic devices, including smart/cell phones, must be turned off and stored, preferably in the child's backpack.
