**The Silvia Mazzeo Pule Scholarship Award** is available to a San Juan Elementary School alumnus who meets the following criteria:

- Spent a minimum of three years at San Juan Elementary School
- Has continuously remained in the Two-Way Immersion Program through 12th grade
- Is a graduating senior
- Currently enrolled in one of the four Capistrano Unified School District high schools who offer the Spanish Two-Way Immersion Program: San Juan Hills High School, San Clemente High School, Dana Hills High School or Capistrano Valley High School

The winner will be selected based on academic achievement, letter of recommendation, and the submission of a 500-word essay written in the applicant's non-native language.



Please thoroughly review the eligibility criteria, application materials, and submission instructions outlined below.

SJCEF has formed a Scholarship Committee with members who are fluent in both English and Spanish and includes SJCEF board members, parents, teachers, and Señora Pule. The Committee will review all application materials and select a winner.

The scholarship will be presented at the Senior Awards Ceremony in May 2026. We would also like the scholarship award recipients to attend our school's Spring Festival and be recognized on April 17, 2026.

Scholarship applications are due March 6, 2026.

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

You must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for this scholarship opportunity:

- San Juan Elementary School alumnus for a minimum of three years
- Graduating senior who has been a student in the Spanish Dual Immersion Program from Kindergarten through the 12th grade in the Capistrano Unified School District
- Graduating from San Juan Hills High School, San Clemente High School, Dana Hills High School, or Capistrano Valley High School
- Academic achievement with a minimum 3.0 GPA

#### **Scholarship Application Materials**

A complete application includes the following:

- High School Transcript
- 500-word written essay. Essay must be written in the applicant's non-native language and must follow one of these two prompts:
  - 1. "The Two Way Immersion Program influenced my life..."
    "El Programa de Dos Idiomas influenció mi vida..."

OR

- 2. "My future as a multilingual adult will be..."

  "Mi futuro como un adulto multilingüe será ..."
- Letter(s) of recommendation from teachers and/or academic advisors (not to exceed two)
- Completed application

#### **Submission Instructions & Procedure**

- Deadline for submission is **Friday, March 6, 2026**.
