



Football Section Champions!!!



Last Saturday night our Varsity Football team claimed the Northern Section title against the Orland Trojans for the first time since 1989. The game was a hard-fought battle on both sides, with our offense and defense delivering clutch performances when it mattered most.

Marcus Duncan powered the offense with 113 rushing yards on 16 carries, including a touchdown that helped set the tone early. Eli Punzo added balance through the air, completing 5 of 8 passes for 67 yards, while also contributing 46 yards rushing. The night's biggest playmakers also included Jase Griggs, with 71 rushing yards, and two touchdowns, accounting for 12 of the teams 18 points. In the receiving game, Riley Engleman led with 31 yards, and Carson Nako added a key 14-yard grab.

The football team finished with 301 total yards, 234 on the ground and 67 through the air showcasing a balanced, resilient offense.

With the 18-15 victory, we not only advance but also secure a historic milestone: our first section title in 36 years. The win marks a defining moment for the program and a celebration decades in the making for our Gridley community.

The team plays again tomorrow against the Lincoln High School Lions at 7:30 in San Jose for the first round of state playoffs. Good luck boys!



Lady Bulldog Holiday Classic

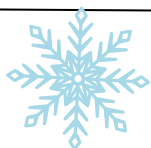
