#### 26/27 Cut-Off Dates

- Kindergarten: Child should be 5 years old before September 2nd (birthdate between 09/02/2020-09/01/2021)
- Transitional Kindergarten: Child should be 4 years old before September 2nd (birthdate between 09/02/2021-09/01/2022)
