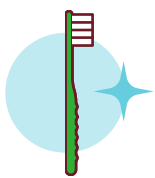
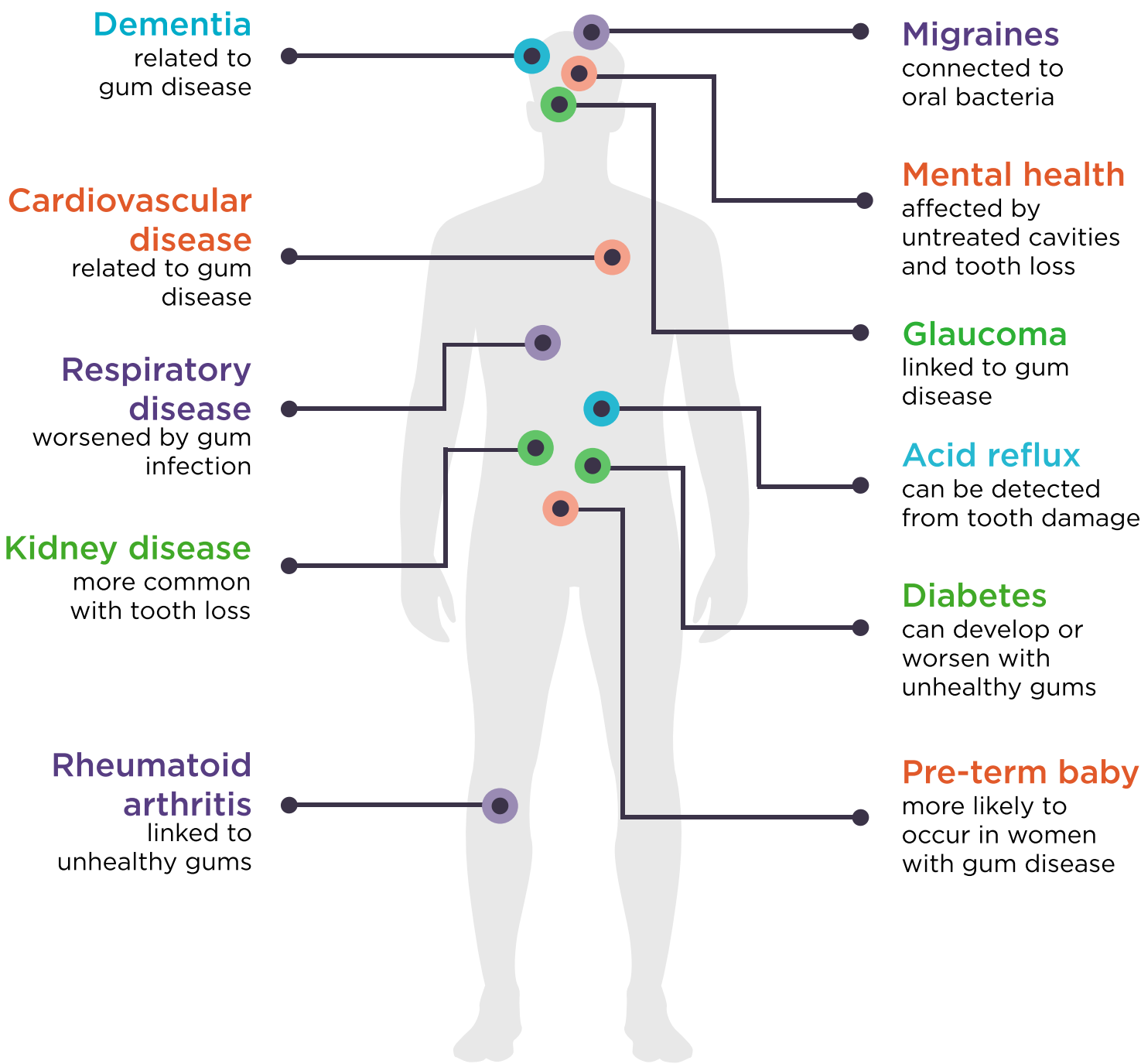


Did you know?
